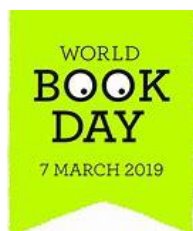
Hope you have enjoyed the term so far. The Spring Term is always jam packed with celebrations and special events and the following dates represent just some of the events we are marking.

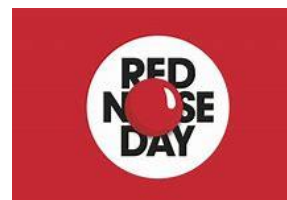


If you are stuck for a costume, we have a range of dressing-up clothes at Pre-school. Just ask before World Book Day and we'll sort you out.
